

Leśne Campsite — Rules & Regulations

Staying on the campsite grounds implies acceptance of these rules. Please familiarise yourself with them before arrival.

- 01 The Leśne campsite is private property. Being on the premises implies acceptance of these rules and regulations.

- 02 A stay day is counted from the moment of arrival until **13:00** of the following day. Guests must leave the campsite by this time, and may not leave their vehicle on the site or at the entrance car park.

- 03 Departure after **13:00** automatically incurs an additional charge equal to the cost of another night, which does not constitute an extension of the stay.

- 04 The number of pitches is limited. Please book your stay by phone.

- 05 Registration and payment formalities (cash only) must be completed on the day of arrival at reception between **8:00 and 21:00**.

- 06 Fees are collected in advance; an earlier departure does not entitle the guest to a refund.

- 07 Reception is open 24 hours. New guests are checked in between **8:00 and 21:00**. Arrivals before 8:00 or after 21:00 may enter the site only with prior agreement from reception or management.

- 08 Quiet hours are observed between **23:00 and 6:00**.

- 09 On check-in the guest receives:
 - a general stay card,
 - self-service barrier access in the form of an SMS code,
 - an identification number for the tent or caravan and the car, for which a refundable deposit of **PLN 50.00** is collected.

- 10 The identification number must be placed visibly on the tent or caravan.

- 11 The stay card should be kept on your person at all times.

- 12 The car pass must be placed behind the windshield in a way that allows the information on it to be read from outside the vehicle.

- 13 Entry to the campsite is permitted only upon presentation of a valid stay card. Staff and management are entitled to check stay cards at any time.

- 14 In the event of an unregistered stay on the premises, an additional fee of **PLN 50.00** per person for each day of stay will be charged.

- 15 Stays may be extended provided that registration numbers are still available. The intent to extend a stay must be reported at reception 2 days before the planned departure.
-
- 16 Reception staff reserves the right to refuse check-in to individuals or organised groups likely to violate these rules or standards of peaceful coexistence, without stating further reasons.
-
- 17 Guests may choose their pitch freely, but not on marked access lanes. When setting up a caravan or tent, please respect the access paths of neighbouring pitches.
-
- 18 Electrical hook-up is available on the campsite. Connecting and disconnecting from the electrical installation is performed exclusively by campsite staff.
-
- 19 Electrical hook-up and consumption are limited by the technical capacity of the infrastructure. Caravans and campervans are prioritised, tents where possible. Disconnection must be requested at least one hour before departure.
-
- 20 Guests using electrical hook-up should bring a sufficiently long extension cable suitable for the distribution box.
-
- 21 Sanitary facilities are accessible around the clock. Washrooms and toilets are free of charge. Showers require a token purchased at reception.
-
- 22 Children on the premises must remain under the care of their parents or another responsible adult. The use of the playground and on-site equipment by children must be supervised by adults. Management and staff take no responsibility for unattended children.
-
- 23 Pets may stay on the campsite only with a valid vaccination card. Dogs must be kept on a leash and walked with a muzzle.
-
- 24 Pet owners are required to clean up after their animals.
-
- 25 The speed limit for vehicles on the campsite is **10 km/h**. Car owners are also asked to limit driving during quiet hours.
-
- 26 The following are strictly prohibited:
- lighting open fires,
 - smoking inside the TV tent,
 - washing clothes or dishes in the washrooms,
 - bathing animals in the washrooms or water-draw point,
 - using the water-draw point for any purpose other than its intended use.
-
- 27 Waste segregation is mandatory on the campsite. Rubbish bags can be collected at reception.
-
- 28 Labelled rubbish containers are located in the car park before the campsite entrance. Please flatten plastic bottles and large cardboard packaging before disposal to reduce waste volume.

-
- 29 Visitors of campsite guests may remain on the premises between **8:00 and 23:00**. Visits beyond 23:00 require registration.
-
- 30 Visitors may be brought onto the campsite only by a registered guest, who must first inform reception who is visiting and for how long. In special cases, simply notifying reception of the number of visitors is sufficient.
-
- 31 Visitors of our campsite guests are not exempt from parking fees.
-
- 32 A guest leaving the campsite is obliged to return the number tag and car pass at reception, to clean up the pitch, and to remove any traces of tent trenching or awning anchors.
-
- 33 The management accepts no responsibility for theft or damage of belongings brought by the guest.
-
- 34 The guest bears full material responsibility for campsite property. In the event of any damage to on-site equipment, they are required to pay compensation at the prices currently in effect.
-
- 35 Non-compliance with these rules authorises the management to deny further stay on the campsite.
-
- 36 Ignorance of these rules does **not** release anyone from liability.
